*Douglas, MA – (October 18, 2023): Douglas Community Electricity Aggregation is announcing the renewal of the program through the term December 2023 – November 2025. Most participants do not need to take any action to remain in the program and receive the new pricing for the product in which they are currently enrolled. Read on for more information.*

Most participants in Douglas's program use "Douglas Standard", which offers the same renewable energy content as National Grid Basic Service. "Douglas Standard" participants will automatically receive the new program pricing on their December meter read. Due to requirements from the Department of Public Utilities, participants in the 50% and 100% renewable product must affirmatively re-enroll in a product of their choosing to remain in the program.
