The Town of Dedham announces the renewal of its Dedham Community Electricity Aggregation (CEA) program, with new prices for the period November 2025 until November 2028. Dedham CEA is a group purchasing program, operated by the Town since 2016, which provides electricity supply options to help residents and businesses manage costs and increase renewable energy use.

The Town is excited that it has secured lower prices for all supply options! Current participants do not need to take any action to remain in the Dedham CEA program and receive the new pricing.

All new Dedham CEA prices will be fixed for 36 months, beginning November 2025 until November 2028. The Dedham CEA program will be served by our supplier, Constellation:
